SUBJECT: Suspension of Application of 49 C.F.R. Part 395 for Delivery Drivers of

Residential Heating Fuel

As DPS Commissioner, I am in receipt of your request for an extension of the suspension of application of 49 C.F.R. Part 395 for delivery drivers of residential heating fuel due to the severe weather event which began on January 14, 2024.

Pursuant to the delegation of authority by Governor J. Kevin Stitt in accordance with 49 C.F.R. § 390.23, I hereby extend the suspension of application of 49 C.F.R. Part 395 for delivery drivers of residential heating fuel due to the severe weather which began January 14, 2024. The extension of suspension of 49 C.F.R Part 395 shall commence 12:00 a.m. CST on Wednesday, January 17, 2024, and cease 11:59 p.m. CST on Sunday, January 21, 2024. This suspension of application of 49 C.F.R Part 395 applies for all counties in Oklahoma.

This limited suspension of 49 C.F.R. Part 395 shall not be construed as the declaration of a natural or man-made emergency under the provisions of the Oklahoma Emergency Management Act of 2003 or any other Oklahoma law. Nor shall the limited suspension of 49 C.F.R. Part 395 be construed as an exemption from the enforcement of any other laws, regulations, or rules pertaining to the operation of commercial motor vehicles.
