

Propane Vehicle and Infrastructure Rebate Program

Convert Your Vehicles to Propane and Install Infrastructure to Receive Rebate(s).

The Oklahoma Propane Education and Safety Council will pay you to convert your vehicles to propane. In addition, you can receive a rebate to install propane infrastructure on your property.

Conversions and Installation must be completed between March 1 and December 31, 2026

If awarded a rebate(s), the authorized submitter must complete an electronic survey before funds are disbursed.

Propane Vehicle Conversion

Who is Eligible? Individuals, Fleets, School Systems, Municipalities, Companies, Corporations, Etc.

What are the Rules?

- A maximum of three (3) vehicles per entity are eligible for rebates;
- The rebate amount is \$1,000 per engine liter;
- Maximum vehicle mileage is 50,000;
- The propane system must be EPA Certified;
- Maximum age of the vehicle will be determined by the manufacturer of the propane system;
- Conversion must be performed by a technician certified through the Oklahoma Department of Labor;
- Paid receipts (not invoices) must be submitted with rebate application to receive funds;
- Rebate funds will be issued to the individual/entity applying for the rebate.
- Rebate funds may be assigned to the propane marketer by the individual/entity.
- The manufacturer will be contacted to confirm the system qualifies for rebate.
- Applications will be considered on a first come/first served basis as long as funds are available.
- Any omissions and/or errors will negate the rebate process

Propane Infrastructure Installation

Who is Eligible? Fleets, School Systems, Municipalities, Companies, Corporations, Etc.

What are the Rules?

- Propane vehicle conversion must be completed in order to receive infrastructure rebate funds;
- If converting three (3) vehicles, entity is eligible for \$5,000 toward infrastructure;
- If converting five (5) vehicles or more, entity is eligible for \$10,000 toward infrastructure;
- Only concrete, posts, electrical, crash protection, etc. is eligible for a rebate;
- Tank and dispenser are not eligible for a rebate;
- Paid receipts (not invoices) must be submitted with rebate application to receive funds;
- Rebate funds will be issued to the entity purchasing the infrastructure for a propane filling station.

How to Apply?

- Visit www.oklpgas.org for an application.
- Once completed, submit your application to the OPESC.
- You will receive notification of acceptance.
